Dr. Wei Yu received his Bachelor Degree from China Medical University in 1984, and his M.D. from Peking Union Medical College in Beijing, China in 1991. Upon completing his medical training, he completed a post-doctoral fellowship in the Department of Radiology at the University of California San Francisco (UCSF) from 1993 to 1995, followed by a Visiting Associate Professorship in the same department at UCSF from 1997 to 1998. In 1999, Dr. Yu was promoted to Professor of Radiology at Peking Union Medical College Hospital.

Dr. Yu's area of expertise is musculoskeletal diseases and osteoporosis, with a particular focus on diagnostic and quality control aspects of bone densitometry. He has published approximately 80 articles related to this field. From 1997 to 1999 he was a member of the WHO scientific group on prevention and management of osteoporosis, and has also served as a standing committee member and secretary-general of the Chinese Society for Osteoporosis and Bone Mineral Research (CSOBMR) of the Chinese Medical Association (CMA) since 2001. In November 2012, Dr. Yu was appointed Vice President of CSOBMR.
